OVERVIEW

The Partnership for Public Service (Partnership) is a nonpartisan, nonprofit organization that works to revitalize our federal government by inspiring a new generation to serve and transforming the way the government works. Sponsored by CFPB in conjunction with the Partnership, the *CFPB Ambassadors* program provides a paid opportunity for students across the country to promote opportunities within the agency as part of this mission.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS

Student ambassadors will work approximately <u>five hours per week</u> throughout the academic year. Ambassadors will participate in regular webinars and phone calls with a Partnership coach and must complete a variety of activities, including:

- Beginning and end-of-year meetings with career services
- Conduct meetings with faculty/staff members
- Conduct meetings with student group leaders
- Implement general marketing activities
- Organize presentations or workshops
- Hold one-on-one or small group advising sessions
- Publish articles or blogs or post on campus social media
- Generate a list student and campus contacts
- Conduct regional outreach to a nearby college/university (if applicable)
- Participate in a campus career fair (if applicable)

BENEFITS AND COMPENSATION

CFPB ambassadors can expect a variety of benefits from their participation in the program, including:

- \$2,000 stipend (\$1,000 per semester)
- Develop in-demand skills
- Bolster your experience and resume
- Stay in contact with CFPB
- Build networks of academic and professional contacts
- Receive individualized feedback and assistance from a Partnership coach

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enrolled as a student in an accredited degree granting college or university in the United States for the 2016-17 academic year. (Note: You may not study abroad at any point during your tenure as an ambassador.)
- Able to participate for the entire 2016-17 academic year
- Exhibit a commitment to public service, possess strong interpersonal and communication skills, demonstrate the ability to manage and prioritize multiple and varied assignments, be involved and show leadership in extracurricular activities
- Availability to work approximately five hours per week
